

IN HIM verses

IN CHRIST

Romans 3:24 Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is **in Christ** Jesus,

Romans 6:11 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God **in Christ** Jesus our Lord.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life **in Christ** Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are **in Christ** Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life **in Christ** Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:39 Nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is **in Christ** Jesus our Lord.

Romans 12:5 So we, being many, are one body **in Christ**, and individually members of one another.

1 Corinthians 1:2 To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified **in Christ** Jesus, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

1 Corinthians 1:30 But of Him you are **in Christ** Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so **in Christ** all shall be made alive.

2 Corinthians 1:21 Now He who establishes us with you **in Christ** and has anointed us is God,

2 Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph **in Christ**, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.

2 Corinthians 3:14 But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away **in Christ**.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is **in Christ**, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

2 Corinthians 5:19 That is, that God was **in Christ** reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 11:3 But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is **in Christ**.

Galatians 2:4 And this occurred because of false brethren secretly brought in (who came in by stealth to spy out our liberty which we have **in Christ** Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage),

Galatians 3:13,14 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles **in Christ** Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Galatians 3:26 For you are all sons of God through faith **in Christ** Jesus.

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one **in Christ** Jesus.

Galatians 5:6 For **in Christ** Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.

Galatians 6:15 For **in Christ** Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation.

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places **in Christ**.

Ephesians 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things **in Christ**, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.

Ephesians 2:6 And raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places **in Christ** Jesus.

Ephesians 2:7 That in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us **in Christ** Jesus.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created **in Christ** Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 2:13 But now **in Christ** Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

Ephesians 3:6 That the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise **in Christ** through the gospel,

Ephesians 4:32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God **in Christ** forgave you.

Philippians 3:13-14 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God **in Christ** Jesus.

Colossians 1:28 Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect **in Christ** Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead **in Christ** will rise first.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God **in Christ** Jesus for you.

1 Timothy 1:14 And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are **in Christ** Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:9 Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us **in Christ** Jesus before time began.

2 Timothy 1:13 Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are **in Christ** Jesus.

2 Timothy 2:1 You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is **in Christ** Jesus.

2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is **in Christ** Jesus with eternal glory.

2 Timothy 3:15 And that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is **in Christ** Jesus.

Philemon 1:6 That the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you **in Christ** Jesus.

2 Peter 1:8 For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful **in** the knowledge of our Lord Jesus **Christ**.

2 John 1:9 Whoever transgresses and does not abide **in** the doctrine of **Christ** does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.

IN HIM

John 1:4 **In Him** was life, and the life was the light of men.

John 3:15,16 That whoever believes **in Him** should not perish but have eternal life. For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes **in Him** should not perish but have everlasting life.

Acts 17:28 For **in Him** we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.'

2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and **in Him** Amen, to the glory of God through us.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God **in Him**.

Ephesians 1:4 Just as He chose us **in Him** before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

Ephesians 1:7 **In Him** we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

Ephesians 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—**in Him**.

Ephesians 1:11 **In Him** also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will.

Ephesians 1:13 **In Him** you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise.

Philippians 3:9 And be found **in Him**, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;

Colossians 1:17 And He is before all things, and **in Him** all things consist.

Colossians 1:19 For it pleased the Father that **in Him** all the fullness should dwell,

Colossians 2:6 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk **in Him**.

Colossians 2:7 Rooted and built up **in Him** and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.

Colossians 2:9 For **in Him** dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.

Colossians 2:10 And you are complete **in Him**, who is the head of all principality and power.

Colossians 2:11 **In Him** you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ,

1 John 1:5 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and **in Him** is no darkness at all.

1 John 2:5 But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are **in Him**.

1 John 2:6 He who says he abides **in Him** ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

1 John 2:8 Again, a new commandment I write to you, which thing is true **in Him** and in you, because the darkness is passing away, and the true light is already shining.

1 John 2:27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide **in Him**.

1 John 2:28 And now, little children, abide **in Him**, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming.

1 John 3:3 And everyone who has this hope **in Him** purifies himself, just as He is pure.

1 John 3:5 And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and **in Him** there is no sin.

1 John 3:6 Whoever abides **in Him** does not sin. Whoever sins has neither seen Him nor known Him. 1 John 3:24

1 John 4:13 By this we know that we abide **in Him**, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.

1 John 5:14,15 Now this is the confidence that we have **in Him**, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are **in Him** who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.

IN THE BELOVED

Ephesians 1:6 To the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted **in the Beloved**.

IN THE LORD

Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light **in the Lord**. Walk as children of light

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong **in the Lord** and in the power of His might.

IN WHOM

Ephesians 2:21 **In whom** the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord,

Ephesians 2:22 **In whom** you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

Ephesians 3:12 **In whom** we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

Colossians 1:14 **In whom** we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

Colossians 2:3 **In whom** are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

BY CHRIST

Romans 5:15 But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift **by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ**, abounded to many.

Romans 5:17-19 For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.) Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life. For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also **by one Man's obedience** many will be made righteous.

1 Corinthians 1:4 I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you **by Christ Jesus**.

Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but **by faith in Jesus Christ**, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.

Ephesians 1:5 Having predestined us to adoption as sons **by Jesus Christ** to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will.

Philippians 1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are **by Jesus Christ**, to the glory and praise of God.

Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory **by Christ Jesus**.

1 Peter 2:5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God **by Jesus Christ**.

1 Peter 5:10 But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory **by Christ Jesus**, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.

BY HIM

Acts 13:39 And **by Him** everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.

1 Corinthians 1:5 That you were enriched in everything **by Him** in all utterance and all knowledge,

Colossians 1:16 For **by Him** all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

Colossians 1:20 And **by Him** to reconcile all things to Himself, **by Him**, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

Hebrews 13:15 Therefore **by Him** let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.

BY HIMSELF

Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had **by Himself** purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

Hebrews 9:26 He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin **by** the sacrifice of **Himself**.

BY HIS BLOOD

Romans 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified **by His blood**, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near **by the blood of Christ**.

Hebrews 9:11,12 But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but **by His own blood** He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Hebrews 9:14,15 How much more shall **the blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

Hebrews 10:19, 20 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest **by the blood of Jesus**, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh.

1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and **the blood of Jesus Christ** His Son cleanses us from all sin.

BY WHOM

Romans 5:2 **By whom** also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:11 And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, **by whom** we have now received the atonement.

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption **by whom** we cry out, "Abba, Father."

1 Corinthians 1:9 God is faithful, **by whom** you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, **by whom** the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.

Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, **by whom** you were sealed for the day of redemption.

FROM WHOM

Ephesians 4:16 **From whom** the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

Colossians 2:19 And not holding fast to the Head, **from whom** all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase that is from God.

OF CHRIST, THE LORD

1 Corinthians 2:16 For "who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind **of Christ**.

2 Corinthians 2:15 For we are to God the fragrance **of Christ** among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit **of the Lord** is, there is liberty.

Ephesians 3:19 To know the love **of Christ** which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

Colossians 3:24 Knowing that **of the Lord** ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.

2 Thessalonians 3:5 Now may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience **of Christ**.

THROUGH CHRIST

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except **through Me**.

Romans 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God **through our Lord Jesus Christ**,

Romans 5:11 And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, **through whom** we have now received the reconciliation.

Romans 7:4 Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law **through the body of Christ**, that you may be married to another—to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God.

1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory **through our Lord Jesus Christ**.

2 Corinthians 5:18 Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself **through Jesus Christ**, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,

Galatians 4:7 Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God **through Christ**.

Philippians 4:6, 7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds **through Christ Jesus**.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things **through Christ** who strengthens me.

Hebrews 10:10 By that will we have been sanctified **through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ** once for all.

Hebrews 13:20-21 Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, **through Jesus Christ**, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope **through the resurrection of Jesus Christ** from the dead.

THROUGH HIM

John 3:17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world **through Him** might be saved.

Romans 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath **through Him**.

Romans 8:37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors **through Him** who loved us.

1 Corinthians 8:6 Yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and **through whom** we live.

Ephesians 2:18 For **through Him** we both have access by one Spirit to the Father.

Colossians 1:16b ...All things were created **through Him** and for Him.

Colossians 3:17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father **through Him**.

Hebrews 7:25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God **through Him**, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

1 Peter 1:21 Who **through Him** believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

1 John 4:9 In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live **through Him**.

WITH CHRIST

Romans 6:8 Now if we died **with Christ**, we believe that we shall also live with Him,

Romans 8:16-17a The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs **with Christ...**

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified **with Christ**; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Ephesians 2:5 Even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together **with Christ** (by grace you have been saved).

Colossians 2:20 Therefore, if you died **with Christ** from the basic principles of the world, why, as though living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations—

Colossians 3:1 If then you were raised **with Christ**, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God.

Colossians 3:3 For you died, and your life is hidden **with Christ** in God.

WITH HIM

Romans 6:4 Therefore we were buried **with Him** through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man was crucified **with Him**, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.

Romans 6:8 Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live **with Him**.

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not **with Him** also freely give us all things?

2 Corinthians 13:4 For though He was crucified in weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For we also are weak in Him, but we shall live **with Him** by the power of God toward you.

Colossians 2:12 Buried **with Him** in baptism, in which you also were raised **with Him** through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

Colossians 2:13-15 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together **with Him**, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

Colossians 3:4 When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear **with Him** in glory.

2 Timothy 2:11-12 This is a faithful saying: For if we died **with Him**, we shall also live **with Him**. If we endure, we shall also reign **with Him**. If we deny Him, He also will deny us.

BECAUSE OF ME

John 6:57 As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live **because of Me**.

IN ME

John 6:56 He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides **in Me**, and I in him.

John 14:20 At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you **in Me**, and I in you.

John 15:4, 5 Abide **in Me**, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide **in Me**. "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides **in Me**, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

John 15:7, 8 If you abide **in Me**, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that **in Me** you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

IN MY LOVE

John 15:9 As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide **in My love**.

IN HIS NAME

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together **in My name**, I am there in the midst of them.”

Mark 16:17,18 And these signs will follow those who believe: **In My name** they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

John 14:13,14 And whatever you ask **in My name**, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything **in My name**, I will do it.

John 16:23, 24 And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father **in My name** He will give you. Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified **in the Name** of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

MORE...

Some verses that convey the message of who you are, or what you are, or what you have BECAUSE OF CHRIST. (May not use the specific phrases IN HIM, in Whom, etc.)

Matthew 8:17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.

Matthew 18:11 For the Son of Man has come to save that which was lost.

Matthew 18:18-20 Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. "Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.

Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Mark 1:8 I indeed baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.

Mark 11:23, 24 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

John 4:14 But whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.

John 6:40 And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day.”

John 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 14:12 Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.

John 17:23 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.

Galatians 3:29 And if you are Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.

Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 2:13 For it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.

Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

Colossians 1:13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love.

Colossians 1:26-27 The mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Titus 2:14 Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

Titus 3:7 That having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Hebrews 2:9-11 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone. For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren,

Hebrews 2:14, 15 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Hebrews 2:18 For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.

Hebrews 4:14-16 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 7:19, 22 19 For the law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, there is the bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God. 22 By so much more Jesus has become a surety of a better covenant.

Hebrews 8:6 But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.

Hebrews 9:24 For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us.

Hebrews 9:28 So Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.

Hebrews 13:5b, 6 For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." So we may boldly say: "The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

1 Peter 2:21 For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps.

1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit.

1 Peter 5:7 Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 2:1 My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death.

1 John 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

1 John 4:10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

1 John 4:15 Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

1 John 5:1, 4-5 1 Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves Him who begot also loves him who is begotten of Him. 4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. 5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

1 John 5:11, 12 And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

Revelation 1:5, 6 And from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.
